Snack Packs and Sydney Van Services

In response to COVID-19, Sydney Vinnies Van Services (SVVS) have been temporarily suspended until further notice. In the meantime, Vinnies is working in collaboration with a number of other organisations to ensure that our clients have access to daily sandwiches (sourced internally) and pre-packed snack packs from central pickup locations across Sydney.

At present, we are in urgent need of the following donations to our service:

- Cuppa soup/packets of soup;
- Cuppa noodles/packets of noodles;
- Le Snack/Cheese Dippits;
- Family boxes of single-serve chips;

- Muesli bars (nut-free) Please note: muesli bars must be chewy e.g. Uncle Toby's Choc Chip Bars.
