Build Homes, Build Hope



The Vinnies NSW 'Build Homes, Build Hope' Petition for social housing was successful in gaining 11,733 signatures. In October 2020, Jack de Groot (Vinnies NSW CEO) and Brooke Simmons (Vinnies Vice President Social Justice), delivered the petition to Alex Greenwich MP who committed to table it in Parliament.

In November, NSW Government announced 1,280 additional social housing homes in NSW. While any new social housing is welcome, there is still a long way to go.
