#### Vinnies CEO Sleepout Results (17<sup>th</sup> June 2021)

This year, over 1,500 CEOs took part in the Vinnies CEO Sleepout, with over 400 in NSW alone, to raise awareness on the growing issue of homelessness.

Not only was a NSW record set, having raised \$3,116,646, but a national record was also set having raised a total of \$9,274,631 to date. We are extremely grateful for everyone who made the event possible and who donated to the fantastic cause!

### Young & Young Adult Conference Spotlight - UNSW Vinnies Society

During Term 2 Welcome Week, UNSW Vinnies held a stall to introduce new students to the work that Vinnies conducts to help those experiencing disadvantage in the community and how students can get involved in the multitude of volunteering opportunities provided by Vinnies. They then held a Meet and Greet to welcome new members to the Society, in addition to bonding over the Society's shared commitment to offering a 'hand up' to people in need within the community, members enjoyed board games, trivia, and food and snacks. UNSW Vinnies collaborated with the UNSW Volunteer Army on an Amazing Race held on Friday 18 June. Teams embarked on a journey through some of Sydney's top not-for-profit organisations, completing a series of rewarding challenges and volunteering tasks along the way. To raise student awareness of the work and functions of Vinnies stores, Amazing Race teams were tasked to make their way to the Vinnies Darlinghurst Store on Oxford Street. Upon arriving at the Store, teams were informed of the core functions of Vinnies Stores, specifically to offer affordable and high-quality items to the public, foster a greater sense of community, and provide referrals to essential services for those in need. To emphasise the affordable and high-quality nature of Vinnies Store items, teams were presented with a fun, creative challenge: create two complete outfits under \$100 in under 15 minutes.
