#### **Metropolitan Vinnies Vans Services**

Metropolitan Vinnies Vans Services (VVS) has revised operations due to COVID. We now have daytime distribution sites across Greater Sydney providing around 2,500 snack packs per week and other essential supplies.

- Preparation of snack packs and toiletry packs for clients of Vinnies Vans Services

- Macramé bag making for clients of Vinnies Vans Services

The resumption of Night Patrol, Behind the Scenes, Sandwich and Soup Making rosters have been delayed by the recent increase in COVID cases.

We ask all Night Patrol volunteers to be vaccinated and provide their vaccination status to be sighted by Vinnies as soon as possible to assist us with the resumption of service in late February.

### **Prayer of Love**


Dear Father

#### Vinnies Youth & School Students Come Together

In the lead up to Christmas, dedicated Vinnies Youth volunteer and Founder of AllRounders Tuition Company, Alexia Paglia, reached out about the possibility of volunteering to help people in need with students from her tutoring company.



On Saturday, 4<sup>th</sup> December, Alexia and six students participated in an Outreach Day to support Metropolitan Vinnies Van Services. The students each brought in snack donations throughout the school term and then, on the day, they worked together to prepare 41 snack packs for clients experiencing homelessness.

They also prepared cards of hope to go inside each snack pack and wrote thoughtful and inspirational messages for clients to read throughout the holiday season.
