Homelessness Week: Vinnies Metro Schools & Youth Team joined our Vinnies Assist, Community Engagement, and Auburn Vinnies Support Centre at Auburn Youth Centre. We provided information and hampers for the Cumberland Council community.



Busking for Vinnies (Centenary Square, Parramatta): Thanks to our event co-coordinator John Neylan, our talented school performers from Our Lady of Mercy College (Parramatta), Mt Saint Benedict College (Pennant Hills), St Edmund's College (Wahroonga), and Oakhill College (Castle Hill), the Vinnies Winston Hills Conference, and our Vinnies Youth volunteers for participating. Over \$5,400 was raised in support of people experiencing homelessness and hardship in Western Sydney.



The Vinnies Schools & Youth Team has worked with various community organisations and educational institutions offering opportunities for students to be involved in giving a 'hand up and not just a hand out' to those in need. Vinnies is a firm supporter of mental health wellbeing (**RUOK Day** stall with Youth off the Streets, Bankstown) and being good stewards of the environment through recycling & sustainability (Australian Catholic University **Sustainability Day** Stall).



The Vinnies Schools & Youth Team had a very busy Term 3 including presentation of **Mini Vinnies Formation Program** GOLD completion awards to students at St Patrick's Primary School, Blacktown; running an interactive workshop on Human Dignity at **Ignite Conference**; and helping our university Vinnies groups raise over \$2,000 to assist people experiencing homelessness in Sydney.
