### TIPS FOR A GREAT VINNIES HIGH SCHOOL CONFERENCE

#### Prepare your group values and vision

Brainstorm all the values that all members of the School Conference group should adhere to e.g. respect for each other's ideas, kindness and compassion toward others, etc.

The secretary takes notes during the brainstorm and after typing it up, all members should sign their name at the next meeting to show that everyone will uphold the group standards.

#### Use the following model to guide your approach to good works



#### Plan early

Many activities take longer to plan than you think! Always make sure you give yourself 4-6 meetings to plan and execute an idea before you just jump in.

### Involve as many members as possible

Don't let just one or two members do all the work. Even if it is just a small job. Everyone joined the Vinnies High School Conference because they wanted to help in some way.

You might like to create positions in the group to help involve members e.g. younger members can be in charge of making posters to promote activities. Group members that don't like speaking in front of groups might write a reflective article for the school newsletter.

### Think beyond fundraising

There are lots of things that you can do to help others that doesn't involve asking for money.

- Organise a collection drive Food, clothing, toys, hygiene products etc. The sky is the limit!
- Raise awareness about a cause that means something to you- Create posters, an event, a guest speaker, a school survey etc.
- Organise some community outreach visits to the local Nursing home every month to spend some time with the senior citizens, or write letters to children in hospital to brighten their day

We encourage you to involve your whole school community where possible.
